

HISTIO YOUTH AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

Become a Histo Youth Ambassador and make a bigger impact in the lives of others who are affected by histiocytic disorders.

POSITION OVERVIEW: Histo Youth Ambassadors are individuals that give their time and energy in support of the mission of the Histiocytosis Association. Histo Youth Ambassadors are individuals who have first-hand experience with a histiocytic disorder diagnosis and passionately want to help.

GETTING STARTED: Parent/guardian oversight required.

1. Complete an application.
2. Complete the interview process.
3. Sign the Histo Youth Ambassador Agreement.
4. Complete the Histo Youth Ambassador Training.
5. Let's get started so we can help our Histo community.

QUALIFICATIONS: Eligible participants will:

1. We recommend youth ambassadors to be between the ages of 12-17 years old.
2. Have basic computer and organization skills.
3. Have a willingness to learn how to communicate and be an active listener.
4. Have a passionate interest in helping others.

REQUIREMENTS: *Parent/guardian oversight required. (or participation)

1. Attend virtual Histo Youth Ambassador training with Advisor. *
2. Attend virtual Histo Youth Ambassador organizational planning meetings. *
3. Interview a senior ambassador or Histo doctor and write a summary.
4. Host, or co-host, at least one awareness event or activity. *

EXPECTATIONS:

1. Serve as a youth representative for the Histiocytosis Association in your local community and/or region.
2. Use active listening skills, kindness, and respect to exemplify the role of a Histo Youth Ambassador.
3. Increase histio awareness and education by participating in awareness/outreach opportunities.
4. Bring forward the patient voice; provide feedback to drive program development and research priorities.

A Histo Ambassador is PROHIBITED from:

- Giving medical advice, recommending treatments, medications, or testing, etc.
- Sharing confidential information due to HIPAA laws and the Histiocytosis Association's privacy policy.
